This ticket will not be replaced, refunded or exchanged for any reason whatsoever. **ASSUMPTION OF ALL RISKS** Each ticket holder ("Holder") voluntarily assumes all risks and dangers incidental to the event for which the ticket is issued ("Event"), whether occurring prior to, during, or after the Event.
